Challenges – staffing, workload, union directives

- We are getting larger as a school, staffing shortages are having an impact, moving forward there will be some significant challenges
- Shenton College has always grown.
 Historically over time we have tried to invest in annual initiatives that would improve the quality of learning, and improve the quality for a child these have been put in place over and above what is allocated by the department per student.
- Built reserves to allow for this to happen.
- Predicted larger cohort of students than actual figures
- 420 Year 7 students for 2024.
 Approximately 60 students less than expectations.
- Excess funds have been heavily invested in quality teaching, initiatives for students.
- Reserve funds have been allocated toward staffing/ student initiatives for 2024, however moving forward the sustainability of all these initiatives will require reassessment.
- Estimations that by end of 2024 we will plateau at 2900.
- SSTUWA Series of directives have been put in place whilst in bargaining arrangement discussions with the Dept.
