ATTENDANCE

ARRIVING LATE

MISSED ASSESSMENTS FOR UPPER SENIOR SCHOOL

Course outlines and assessment dates are distributed to all students at the commencement of the course and are available on Compass.

At the beginning of each course, all students have access to the course and assessment outline. The College's Assessment Policy states that unauthorised absences will impact a student's performance, with no opportunity to reschedule missed assessments. This policy is in place to ensure fairness and consistency in assessments for all students and to adhere to the guidelines set by the School Curriculum and Standards Authority for senior schooling courses and programs.

Students who miss an assessment task must present a medical certificate to explain their absence. Upon their return they will be required to submit or sit the missed assessment within the learning area allocated timing.

Students who miss an exam must present a medical certificate to explain their absence. An opportunity to sit the missed exam for feedback purposes only may be provided.
